Behavior Policy

Grading Policy

Tests 40% - You will be tested triweekly on the performance of scales and solos.

Attendance 60% - You are expected attend all classes and certain out-of-class activities. Unacceptable lateness or absences may result in a grade drop. Acceptable absences include serious illnesses, family emergencies, and important school events that cannot be rescheduled.

- 2+ pencils (NOT PENS)
